High Five is a non-partisan voter participation project. Our mission is to conduct non-partisan, voter mobilization and participation among registered voters in order to maximize voter turnout. Specifically, we want every registered voter to identify five (5) people who are already registered to vote, and to make sure that they receive and turn in their absentee ballot, participate in early voting or get to their poll to cast their vote for November 3, 2020.

In July 2016, during her stunning convention speech, Michelle Obama coined a phrase that continues to resonate with many Americans, *“When they go low, we go high”*. As we move closer to November 3rd, we want to ensure that we maximize voter turnout. There is no need for constant rhetoric, trickery or mud-slinging, this is a simple pledge campaign based on taking the “high road” and getting the work done. What work? . . . the work of maximizing voter turnout! High Five is an effort to “go high” by emphasizing the simplicity of helping each other and creating a level of accountability among voters.

The goal is to get every registered voter to identify five (5) people and to be responsible for making sure that all five (5) vote, by assisting them in securing and turning in their absentee ballot thirty days prior to November 3, 2020 as required by law, participating in early voting options or by physically taking them to the polls between 7:00am and 7:00pm on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.
